



CROSSCHECK TRAVEL ENTERPRISE (CCTE) Smartpoint Quick Commands

The Travelport Smartpoint application has traditionally contained two *Quick Commands* that apply to Crosscheck Travel (CCTE) Users.

The functions contained within these individual Quick Commands were to:

- a:) allow for the download of Travelport+ Booking Files into CCTE (#DL)
- b:) provide a short cut to run CCTE from within Smartpoint (#CCTE)

Depending on circumstances, the implementation of a Smartpoint upgrade may remove these two CCTE Quick Commands but they can be easily replaced by following a few simple steps within Smartpoint.



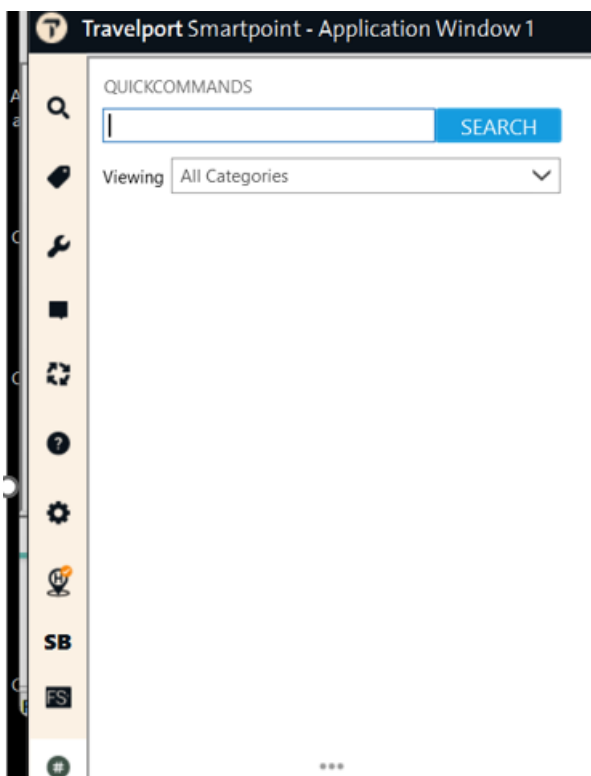
Resetting the **CTE** Quick Commands in Smartpoint

These instructions are based on the Quick Commands screens within Smartpoint Release 12.0.1.51 (V12). Other Smartpoint versions may display the Quick Commands in a different manner, but the instructions still apply.

Adding the **CTE** Download (#DL) Quick Command

In Smartpoint V12, from the icons displayed on the left side of the main screen select the **Tools** option.

Then select **QuickCommands**.



Click on the 'three dots' at the bottom of the screen.

This will open the **QuickCommands** Management screen that displays your current list of Smartpoint Quick Commands.



Select the **Add** button

Complete the fields in this screen as per the following example.

Note that at the field that is labeled **App**: you will need to click on Browse and follow the path to C:\Program Files (x86)\CCTE\Client to select the fpdl.exe file or otherwise just copy across the full path: C:\Program Files (x86)\CCTE\Client\fpdl.exe

(this is assuming that your **CCTE Client** is installed locally on your C: Drive otherwise the drive letter may differ).

Save the screen and the **CCTE Download (#DL)** Quick Command should now be available to use when a Booking File is displayed in Smartpoint.

Adding the CCTE (#CCTE) Smart Command

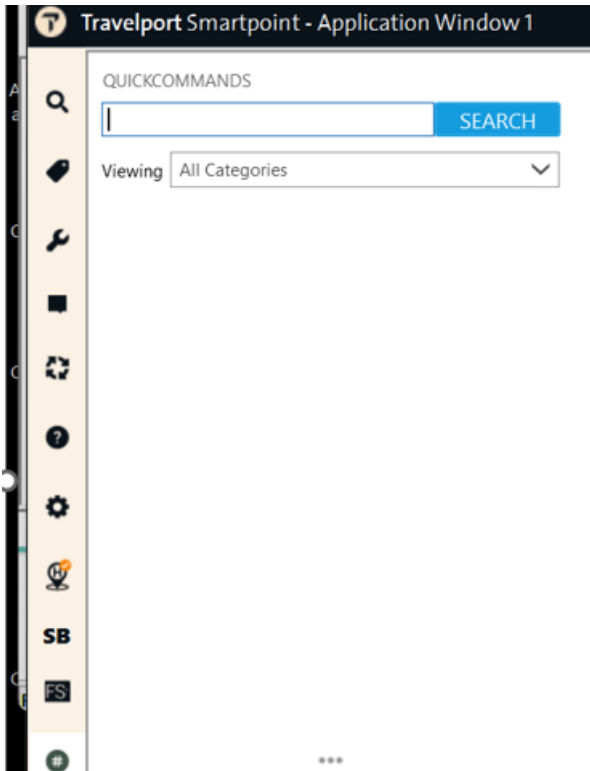
The #CCTE Quick Command originally acted as a Short Cut to run CCTE and is now possibly redundant as most users will open CCTE through an icon from their desktop. Instructions to reset this Quick Command are listed below but there is no actual need to have this as a Quick Command in Smartpoint.

If deciding to add this Quick Command, from the icons displayed on the left side of the main Smartpoint (V12) screen select the **Tools** option.

Then select **QuickCommands**.



Crosscheck Travel (CTE) – Smartpoint Quick Commands



Click on the 'three dots' at the bottom of the screen.

This will open the **QuickCommands** Management screen that displays your current list of Smartpoint Quick Commands.
